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20 True or False

Decide, then check the answer and reason below each statement.

Question 1

On a single/first attempt, the rule requires 45 marks in each paper plus a 150/300 aggregate.

TRUE

This is the standard first-attempt passing condition for JAIIB and CAIIB.

Question 2

On a single/first attempt, candidates need 60 marks in each paper to pass.

FALSE

The first-attempt per-paper floor is 45 marks, not 60.

Question 3

On later attempts, the per-paper minimum for a pending paper rises to 50 marks.

TRUE

The friendlier 45-mark floor applies only to the first attempt; later attempts require 50 per pending paper.

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Question 4

On later attempts, the per-paper minimum stays at 45 marks indefinitely.

FALSE

The per-paper minimum rises to 50 marks for pending papers in attempts after the first.

Question 5

A standalone score of 50 or more in a paper passes that paper outright.

TRUE

Fifty marks clears a subject regardless of the aggregate outcome in that attempt.

Question 6

Papers scored below 50 are automatically carried forward as credit.

FALSE

Credit rollover applies to papers scored 50 or above, not to papers scored below 50.

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Question 7

Candidates get a 2-year window to complete JAIIB or CAIIB from the date of registration.

TRUE

This window equals up to four consecutive attempts to finish the exam.

Question 8

Candidates get unlimited attempts to complete JAIIB or CAIIB within the 2-year window.

FALSE

The window allows only four attempts, not an unlimited number.

Question 9

The 2-year time limit starts only once a candidate sits for their first attempt, not from registration.

FALSE

The clock starts from the first registration date, whether or not an attempt is taken.

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Question 10

Missing the completion deadline means losing credit for previously passed papers.

TRUE

Candidates must re-enroll and forfeit earlier credits if they do not finish within the time limit.

Question 11

A high score in one paper can fully compensate for failing the per-paper minimum in another paper.

FALSE

The per-paper minimum and the aggregate are separate conditions that must both be met.

Question 12

Both the per-paper minimum and the aggregate minimum must be satisfied together to pass.

TRUE

Meeting only one of the two conditions still results in an overall fail.

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Question 13

Scoring 45 in each of three papers for a total of 147 out of 300 results in a pass.

FALSE

An aggregate below 150 out of 300 fails the attempt, even if each paper clears 45.

Question 14

Scoring 45, 60 and 45 across three papers, totalling 150 out of 300, results in a pass.

TRUE

Each paper meets the 45-mark floor and the aggregate reaches the required 150/300.

Question 15

CAIIB includes compulsory papers along with an elective chosen by the candidate.

TRUE

CAIIB combines fixed compulsory subjects with a specialisation elective.

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Question 16

JAIIB and CAIIB papers each carry a maximum of 100 marks.

TRUE

Three 100-mark papers combine for a total of 300 marks in each exam.

Question 17

The aggregate minimum required to pass JAIIB or CAIIB is 150 out of 300 marks.

TRUE

This corresponds to the 50% aggregate threshold applied alongside the per-paper minimum.

Question 18

Results for JAIIB and CAIIB are declared on the official IIBF website.

TRUE

Candidates log in to the official portal to view scorecards and download certificates.

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Question 19

Passed papers remain valid as credit indefinitely, with no time limit.

FALSE

Credit for a passed paper is valid only until the candidate's registration time limit expires.

Question 20

Scoring exactly 45 in each pending paper on a later attempt is sufficient to pass those papers.

FALSE

Once the per-paper bar rises to 50 in later attempts, a score of 45 is no longer sufficient.

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
