Decide, then check the answer and reason below each statement.

Question 1

The CAIIB December 2026 registration window runs from 01 September to 21 September 2026.

TRUE

Correct, this is the 21-day registration window stated for the December 2026 cycle.

Question 2

The CAIIB December 2026 exam window is spread across a single day rather than multiple dates.

FALSE

False; the exams are spread over five days in December across multiple paper combinations.

Question 3

CAIIB exams described in this schedule are conducted in online, remote-proctored mode.

TRUE

Correct, candidates take the exam remotely under proctored supervision.

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Question 4

IIBF conducts CAIIB only once a year, in December.

FALSE

False; IIBF conducts CAIIB twice yearly, in a June cycle and a December cycle.

Question 5

The June 2026 CAIIB cycle exams were held from 31 May to 21 June 2026, per this schedule.

TRUE

Correct, this is the exam period stated for the already-concluded June 2026 cycle.

Question 6

Candidates who are not IIBF members can register for CAIIB directly without becoming a member first.

FALSE

False; non-members must first enroll as ordinary life members before registering for CAIIB.

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Question 7

Only IIBF members who have passed JAIIB are eligible to register for CAIIB.

TRUE

Correct, this is the core eligibility requirement for CAIIB registration.

Question 8

CAIIB registration fees are identical regardless of when in the window a candidate registers.

FALSE

False; fees rise in later registration weeks through a tiered late-fee structure.

Question 9

Registering in Week 1 of the CAIIB registration window avoids any late-fee surcharge.

TRUE

Correct, only the normal exam fee applies during the first week of registration.

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Question 10

The late-fee surcharge for registering in the final week can go up to 500 rupees over the base fee.

FALSE

False; the article states a maximum late-fee surcharge of up to 200 rupees over the base fee.

Question 11

The CAIIB exam consists of five papers total: four compulsory and one elective.

TRUE

Correct, this is the standard CAIIB paper structure described in the schedule.

Question 12

Banking Regulations and Business Laws is an elective CAIIB paper, not a compulsory one.

FALSE

False; Banking Regulations and Business Laws is one of the four compulsory CAIIB papers.

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Question 13

CAIIB elective options include Rural Banking and Central Banking.

TRUE

Correct, both are listed among the five elective choices for CAIIB.

Question 14

Each CAIIB paper in this schedule carries 50 marks and lasts one hour.

FALSE

False; each CAIIB paper carries 100 marks with a duration of 2 hours.

Question 15

There is no negative marking in the CAIIB exam pattern described in this article.

TRUE

Correct, candidates can attempt all questions without a penalty for wrong answers.

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Question 16

A CAIIB candidate must score at least 70 marks in each paper to pass that subject.

FALSE

False; the minimum passing score is 50 marks per paper, or 45 marks with a 50 percent aggregate.

Question 17

IIBF permits a maximum of five attempts or three years from first registration, whichever comes first.

TRUE

Correct, this is the stated attempt and time limit for completing CAIIB.

Question 18

Candidates can register for both the June and December CAIIB cycles in the same calendar year.

TRUE

Correct, each cycle requires separate registration but both can be attempted in one year.

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Question 19

IIBF never declares CAIIB results before six months after the exam.

FALSE

False; IIBF typically declares CAIIB results within 45 days of the final exam date.

Question 20

A CAIIB candidate can only select one elective at registration and cannot change it after submission.

TRUE

Correct, the elective choice is locked in once the registration form is submitted.

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
