Question 1

IIBF RPE stands for Remote Proctored Examination.

TRUE

RPE lets candidates appear for IIBF certificate exams from home under live webcam proctoring.

Question 2

Candidates should log in around 30 minutes before the scheduled RPE exam start time.

TRUE

The early login buffer allows time for identity verification, system checks and camera positioning.

Question 3

IIBF RPE rules allow only a basic calculator with a maximum of 8 functions and a 12-digit display.

TRUE

Scientific, programmable or phone calculators are treated as unfair means in RPE exams.

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Question 4

Phones are strictly prohibited at all times during an IIBF RPE exam.

TRUE

Mobile phones are banned from the RPE exam area regardless of intended use.

Question 5

The webcam and microphone must remain on and uncovered throughout an IIBF RPE exam.

TRUE

Switching off or covering the camera or mic during the exam is treated as a rule violation.

Question 6

Leaving the exam area without the proctor's permission is treated as a rule violation in RPE exams.

TRUE

Candidates must stay within the camera frame unless the proctor authorises them to step away.

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Question 7

If an RPE candidate submits their paper by mistake, no re-examination is permitted.

TRUE

Final submission in the RPE system is irreversible, so candidates must review answers before submitting.

Question 8

By registering for an IIBF RPE exam, candidates consent to their video and audio being recorded.

TRUE

IIBF records RPE sessions for proctoring purposes, and registration implies consent to this recording.

Question 9

An IIBF RPE result can be cancelled even after the exam if misconduct is later detected.

TRUE

Recorded RPE sessions let IIBF review conduct after the exam and cancel results retrospectively if needed.

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Question 10

Scientific and programmable calculators are not allowed in IIBF RPE exams.

TRUE

Only a basic 8-function, 12-digit calculator is permitted; scientific and programmable models count as unfair means.

Question 11

IIBF RPE rules permit candidates to use a scientific calculator as long as it is battery-operated.

FALSE

Only a basic 8-function calculator with a 12-digit display is allowed; scientific calculators are treated as unfair means.

Question 12

Wired headphones are allowed during IIBF RPE exams as long as no music is playing.

FALSE

Headphones and similar equipment are strictly not allowed at any time during RPE exams.

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Question 13

RPE candidates can log out to use the washroom and log back in without any restriction.

FALSE

Re-login is not permitted after logging out, so leaving the session for a washroom break is not allowed.

Question 14

IIBF RPE exams can be taken from a noisy public place like a cafe as long as the internet is stable.

FALSE

The exam must be taken in a private, quiet, well-lit room, and a public or noisy setting can disqualify the attempt.

Question 15

Candidates can freely adjust their computer setup at any point after the RPE exam has started.

FALSE

All system setup must be completed before the exam starts; changes are not allowed once it begins.

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Question 16

IIBF takes responsibility and grants a re-attempt if a candidate's computer fails during an RPE exam.

FALSE

IIBF is not responsible for system failures during RPE exams and the candidate may lose that attempt.

Question 17

A second monitor or device is allowed on the desk during an RPE exam as long as it stays switched off.

FALSE

No second screen or device is permitted in the exam area, and detection can mean the exam is not conducted.

Question 18

A mobile phone's calculator app is an acceptable substitute for a physical calculator in RPE exams.

Phone calculators are barred; only a basic 8-function, 12-digit physical calculator is permitted.

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Question 19

IIBF never informs a candidate's employer even when misconduct is confirmed in an RPE exam.

IIBF can inform the candidate's employer or institute when misconduct is confirmed during an RPE exam.

Question 20

Candidates may briefly cover their webcam during an RPE exam without it counting as a violation.

The webcam must stay uncovered throughout the exam, and covering it is treated as a rule violation.

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
